



Philmont Trail Race – Volunteer Roles

Apply to be a Volunteer for the Philmont Trail Race on August 13th, 2022 by filling out this online form. <https://forms.office.com/r/8ZTNgTNfEW>

Course Marker – Volunteers needed to place and check the course marking along the courses the day before and on the morning of race day. We will also need a few Course Marking Volunteers on the course at key turning points to direct the runners morning of the race.

Aid Station Volunteers – A lot of volunteers are needed to manage the 13 different Aid Stations on all 4 of the Philmont Trail Race courses. Help is needed to set up the aid station, hand out water and snacks during the race, track runners as they come through, and cheer on the runners.

Responsibilities for Aid Station Volunteers Include:

- Set up aid Stations
- Track Runners
- Provide directional support
- Distribute fluids and food
- Collect lost and found items
- Assist the event staff in breaking down aid station

Some of the Aid Station Volunteers will be driven to the Aid Station the night before the race to camp out at the Aid Station to have the station opened up for the runners.

Specific Aid Station Details:

Carson Meadows – Open from 5:45am to 8:30am. 50 Mile and Marathon.

Fish Camp – Open from 6:30am to 9:20am. 50 mile.

Apache Springs – Open 7am to 10 am. 50 Mile

Buck Creek Dropoff – Open 7:30am to 12pm. 50 mile.

Clear Creek – Open 8am – 1:45pm. 50 Mile. A Drop Bag Location.

Thunder Ridge - Open 9am to 3:30pm. 50 Mile – No Philmont staff at this location. This is the older Thunder Ridge Camp not the current one on the more recent Philmont Maps.

Cyphers Mine – Open 9:15am to 4:00pm. 50 Mile.

Hunting Lodge – Open 10am to 5:30pm. 50 Mile.

Clark's Fork – Open 10:30am to 6:15pm. 50 Mile. A Drop Bag Location.

Scheafers Pass – Open 8:30am to 7:30pm. 50 mile, Marathon, Heavy Half. No Staff here or access to water. Will need teams of people to hike water and camp up at Sheaffer's Pass for the weekend. Volunteers for this Aid station will need to hike up to Sheaffer's Pass on 812 and camp in one of the campsites in the camp. They will most likely stay there for the night of 813 and hike back to Clark's Fork for a pickup on 814 in the morning.

Tooth of Time Bear Cables – Open 9am to 10pm. All Races. This is not an Aid Station but need a group to have a Radio as a communication spot and to serve as a blockade to stop any participants from climbing up the final rock scramble to the summit of the Tooth of Time. Any Race participants that get caught going to the summit of the Tooth of Time will be disqualified from the race and not allowed to participate in future years.

Crater Lake – Open 7:30am to 2:00pm. Marathon and Heavy Half.

Miners Park – Open 7:45am to 4:00pm. Marathon and Heavy Half.

Registration Check-in – Assistance with handing out the race packets and check-in race participants into tents the evening before the race and on the race morning.

Finish Line – Several volunteers are needed to setup and clean up the finish line area and help serve the post-race food to the participants. Assistance is needed all day during the race on 813.

Course Sweeper – Volunteers needed to hike or run the course after the last runner to ensure that all runners are accounted for and to clean up course markings after racers have all gone through the course.
