Primary Duties & Responsibilities

- Seeing that the optimal customer service experience is achieved by ensuring excellent commissary
 appearance, maintaining high standards of organization and assisting customers with knowledge, empathy
 and sincerity.
- Be directly responsible to and report to the Commissary Manager.
- Be responsible for cleanliness/organization of the commissary and see that all state, federal and local laws as well as Boy Scouts of America rules pertaining to Health, Sanitation, and Safety are adhered to.
- See that temperatures are taken on all refrigeration and freezer units each day and are posted on temperature charts.
- Greet commissary customers when they arrive at the commissary in person, by phone or by radio. Determine their needs and service those needs as soon as possible.
- Manage the packing, picking, assembling and delivering teams.

- Be responsible for proper distribution of commissary orders to all facilities and see that they are delivered at the proper time.
- Own and develop transportation/assembly processes. Work with the Inventory Specialist to ensure proper allocation of items in the inventory system, Inflow.
- Be responsible for notifying Inventory Specialist of low inventory items so that the orders may be placed.
- Successfully oversee the management of the Commissary Meat Market. Stay in constant communication with all end-users to guarantee that sufficient stock will be available when needed.
- Accept with willingness any other job assignment given by Food Service Management to assure a successful operation at Philmont.
- Complete other duties as assigned by direct supervisor or ranch management as required

- Ability to prioritize tasks and ask for help when needed
- Ability to fuction well in a high-pace and at times stressful environment
