Program Availability Dates: December 28th through March 30th



Fees:

- **Deposit:** \$500 deposit per crew required to hold reservation.
- **Winter Adventure:** \$100/person/day. Add as many days as you like!
- **Travel Nights:** \$35 per person. For crews that need to add a night due to travel needs/restrictions/requirements.
- **Downhill Ski Package:** \$190 per person per day (\$290 with Lessons)
- **Balance:** Fee balance is due upon arrival at Philmont.
- **Refunds:** Deposit fees are **non-refundable and non-transferable** in the event of cancellation.

Reservations:

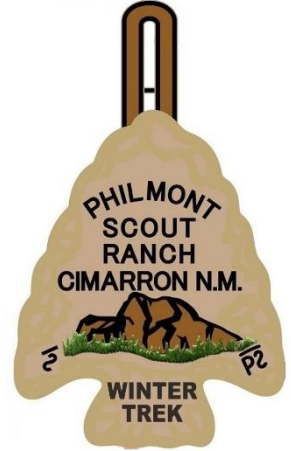
Program Offerings:

Program Notes

All Winter Adventure programs are led by a team of well-trained Guides that have previously served as Rangers or Backcountry Staff. Fees include program delivery by these Guides for the entire experience, plus covers meals, lodging, use of specialized winter gear and clothing from the Winter Gear Room, zero degree sleeping bags, 4-season tents, stoves, fuel, and of course, a special Winter Adventure patch! (Additional fees for specialized programs such as Ski Packages, Casita, Winter Treks, etc.)
