Fees:

- **<u>Deposit</u>**: \$500 deposit per crew required to hold reservation.
- Winter Adventure: \$100/person/day. Add as many days as you like!
- <u>**Travel Nights:**</u> \$35 per person. For crews that need to add a night due to travel needs/restrictions/requirements.
- **Downhill Ski Package:** \$190 per person per day (\$290 with Lessons)
- Balance: Fee balance is due upon arrival at Philmont.
- **<u>Refunds</u>**: Deposit fees are *non-refundable and non-transferable* in the event of cancellation.

Program Offerings:


